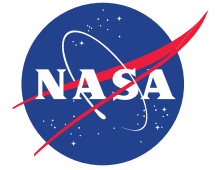


Make NASA Climate Kids Pumpkins!

Directions:

1. Print this template.
2. Place the paper on the pumpkin and secure it with tape.
3. With a black permanent marker, slowly trace the outline of the shape. The marker will bleed through the paper and leave marks on the pumpkin for you to use as a guide.
4. Remove the paper.
5. Use your black marker to trace the outline of the shape.
6. Fill in the design with the black marker or black paint.



A whopping 96.5 percent of water on Earth is in our **oceans**, covering 71 percent of the surface of our planet. And at any given time, about 0.001 percent is floating above us in the atmosphere. If all of that water fell as rain at once, the whole planet would get about 1 inch of rain!
